- a. The Parking Authority shall, as part of its ferry bus schedule, to the Edgewater Ferry Terminal, add one stop to its route in the Borough for transportation of Borough residents. Borough residents must show proof of residency, upon request. The bus stop shall be located at Lafayette and Palisade Avenue, in the Borough.
- b. Fort Lee residents shall have first priority on a first come basis.
- c. The Parking Authority shall not be responsible to any residents for delays or lack of capacity.
- d. The Parking Authority will use its best efforts to advise the Borough of any interruption in service or suspension of same and to the extent the Parking Authority publishes its ferry bus schedule or provides notices relative to the ferry bus schedule, such notices shall also be provided to the Borough so that the Borough may take measures to keep its own residents apprised of the ferry bus schedule as well as any interruption or suspension of service.
- 4. Insurance. The Parking Authority shall at all times have in place commercial bus and transportation insurance through either a premium based commercial insurance company or the municipal joint insurance fund and excess liability fund and which shall cover any loss to property or person occasioned by the Parking Authority's operation of its transportation system and which shall also cover the Borough as an additional insured. Upon the Borough's request the parking authority shall provide the Borough with adequate proof of the existence of this insurance.
